
Lawrenceburg's art deco Crockett Theatre was built in 1950, complete with a custom-laid terrazzo lobby floor, and is one of the few theatres from this era still operating in the United States. It is listed on the National Historic Registry and has been lovingly refurbished by the Crockett Theatre Board.

Groups such as The Singing Carter Family with Mother Maybelle and the Carter girls have graced its stage. Reel-to-reel features such as Gone with the Wind, Smokey and the Bandit, and Elvis movies have entertained full houses. Many a child growing up in Lawrenceburg fondly remembers being on stage at the Theatre for dance recitals, band competitions, and other community events. Today, the stage is named to honor the work of Emmy Award-winning actor Michael Jeter, a native of Lawrenceburg, TN. It is actively used for performances and conferences.

Come to historic downtown Lawrenceburg to enjoy your choice of arts and events, then browse the Square for antique shops, stores, and restaurants that you won't find anywhere else!

Lawrenceburg has an active and talented Community Theatre Group that produces plays throughout the year, including a Christmas play.









James Gordon Freeze is a native of Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, (the birthplace of Southern Gospel Music). The first twenty years of his career was spent as either a drummer, pianist, bass guitarist or vocalist for some of the Legends of Gospel Music. In 2016, he was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame, (Nashville), due to his work with Rex Nelon & The Nelons. He continues to be a producer for his own independent record company, Oasis Records & Productions. He is also a partner in music publishing with Music by Oasis/BMI. Long time member of the Nashville Musicians Association and American Federation of Musicians since 1969.

The Kellys began singing in 1959 as a family of two brothers, Jim and Sonny, and their wives, Ruth and Minnie Paul. The Kellys got their touring start by singing at home around the area until a gentleman from Franklin, TN invited them to sing at his church. They booked seven singings at other churches from that one evening, and the Kelleys have been touring ever since. An all male quartet for the past 21 years, their powerful voices will blow you away.

From Muskogee, OK, Zach and Colton Swon first came to national attention through Season 4 of the Voice, though they've been performing since they could walk. Originally debuting in their parents' Gospel show, the two have a wide performance range.

Their modern country music is heartfelt and upbeat, influenced by their lives and inspirations. Crisp, standout vocals, heartfelt music, and tight harmonies are a hallmark of this diverse and impressive duo, and their soulful approach to modern country has charmed audiences around the world.
